Grayce Parker started her career in 1975 as a ticket agent for **Gulf Air**, located on the Spit in Campbell River B.C. She was soon promoted to a Dispatcher.

In 1978 Grayce transferred to Port Hardy, then a new coastal town which presented her with an exciting challenge. Amphibian Aircraft were operating out of Port Hardy and it was here she met Villi Douglas, the base manager, whom she later married.

Grayce continued to work as a dispatcher throughout her career, transitioning from Gulf Air to Coastal Airlines and eventually to Air BC. She and Villi transferred to YVR South Terminal on the lower mainland, where she worked until she retired. Grayce and Villi continued to live there until Villi's death in July 2024.
