Harry Brown was a successful pilot for 35 years until he retired in the 1990's. The photograph was taken in 1957 in Port Hardy and his obituary was published in the Times Colonist. With the obituary are condolences from **Roy Reaville** and his wife and from co-workers who remembered him from Port Hardy and Campbell River. Harry worked for both **BC Airlines** and **Pacific Western Airlines**.

At **BC Airlines** he was a contemporary of **Justin de Goutiere** who has a story of them both involved in the rescue of the survivor of a Cessna crash in Dorothy Lake. The pilot of the Cessna had not survived and the autopsy found that he died of a heart attack as he took off from the lake. Both the pilot and the survivor were captains of a major airline.
